

From witch doctor to devout Christian

Pulmaya's life was once filled with suffering and challenges. A former witch doctor in Nepal, she was deeply entrenched in religious rituals, believing spirits controlled every aspect of her life.

"The spirits would make me suffer," she recalls. "It was difficult for me to make ends meet. I had to eat different food than my family."

During that time, Pulmaya's sister, who is Christian, talked with her about Jesus. But it was when her grandson started attending church and sharing the gospel with her that Pulmaya's heart began to change.

After listening to her grandson for over a year, Pulmaya decided to go to church herself. Her experience was life-changing. She shares: "The first day I went, I felt like weeping a lot. I found what I'd been searching for when I heard the chorus and the songs."

The country of Nepal has traditionally been a staunch Hindu kingdom. Yet the Christian Church has grown rapidly in recent years—leading to increased persecution for new believers like Pulmaya.

Anti-conversion laws were introduced in 2017, making it extremely difficult for people to share their faith. It is also a crime to proselytize.

Nepal has a vibrant oral culture—roughly 23% of its citizens are unable to read or write. Today, you're shining the hope of the gospel into the



darkest places, thanks to audio and SD card Bibles. Before receiving her solar-powered audio Bible from GCR partners, Pulmaya needed someone to read the Bible to her.

Now she listens to God's Word morning and night, finding comfort and strength in the midst of her trials. When Pulmaya became a Christian, some of her family members disowned her and told her she was not welcome in their homes. Her neighbors have stopped inviting her to dinners. But being able to listen to the Bible sustains not only Pulmaya, but others in her small Christian community. Now, they pray more people will be blessed in the same way. Another Nepali Christian woman shares:

"Those who could not read and write in our church can learn now if everyone can get a Bible like us. That's what we are praying for, that everyone can get a Bible like we did."

After Binita was discharged, she decided to go to church despite experiencing persecution from those who warned her not to leave Hinduism.


Her faith only strengthened when she received an audio Bible. Today, her most heartfelt wish is for her family to know Jesus. She shares:

Arjun explains: "It brings hope, especially in places where people are isolated. This can be a friend to them, their Word they can hear. People are coming to know Christ."


