Unshakable faith in India

Suman was not in the fields when her Hindu uncle and cousins decided to viciously attack her Christian relatives. When the shocking display of violence was over, Suman's sister, Bindu, lay dead. Suman and her family had no choice but to flee for their lives.

In the small village near Nagpur, India, where Suman lives, most everyone is Hindu. Suman herself was raised Hindu and never considered converting to Christianity.

That was, until her brother—Bima—became ill.

Nothing seemed to help until Bindu, who had already embraced Christ, suggested they turn to Jesus.

"As soon as we went to the church and gave it to the Lord, it didn't even take a week. Everything was fine in one or two days." After the miraculous healing, Suman and Bima both gave their lives to Christ. But their decision increased their risk for harassment ... and even worse.

Sadly, they paid a heavy price for their faith, losing everything—their home, livelihood, and most devastatingly, their beloved Bindu—in a brutal act of hatred brought by their very own relatives.

The persecution that Suman and her family experienced is, tragically, not uncommon. In recent years, India has seen a dramatic rise in mob attacks and hostility against Christians.

Under Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), radical Hindu nationalism has fueled hatred and intolerance against religious minorities. The BJP seeks to define Indian identity solely in terms of Hindu culture, which has only emboldened extremist groups who view Christianity as a threat to Indian culture and values.

The risk of violence—as well as India's strict anti-conversion laws—has made it difficult for anyone to follow Christ without fearing for their safety.


Suman's story is just one example of incredible faith and resilience in the face of severe persecution—though it serves as a stark reminder of the cost of faith in regions hostile to the gospel.
